"If you look at the percentage of MIOSHA related fatalities related to "line of fire/stuck by" incidents in 2021, it is evident that it is a serious issue that needs to be investigated and talked about. The best way to avoid these incidents is to identify and eliminate the line of fire/struck by hazard, so that no one in the work area can be injured by that hazard.— *Doug Hill, Consumers Energy*
