



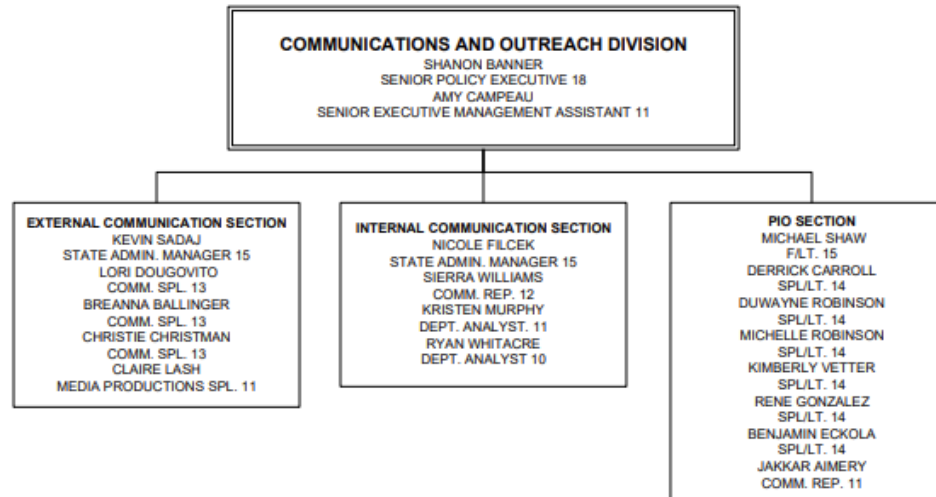

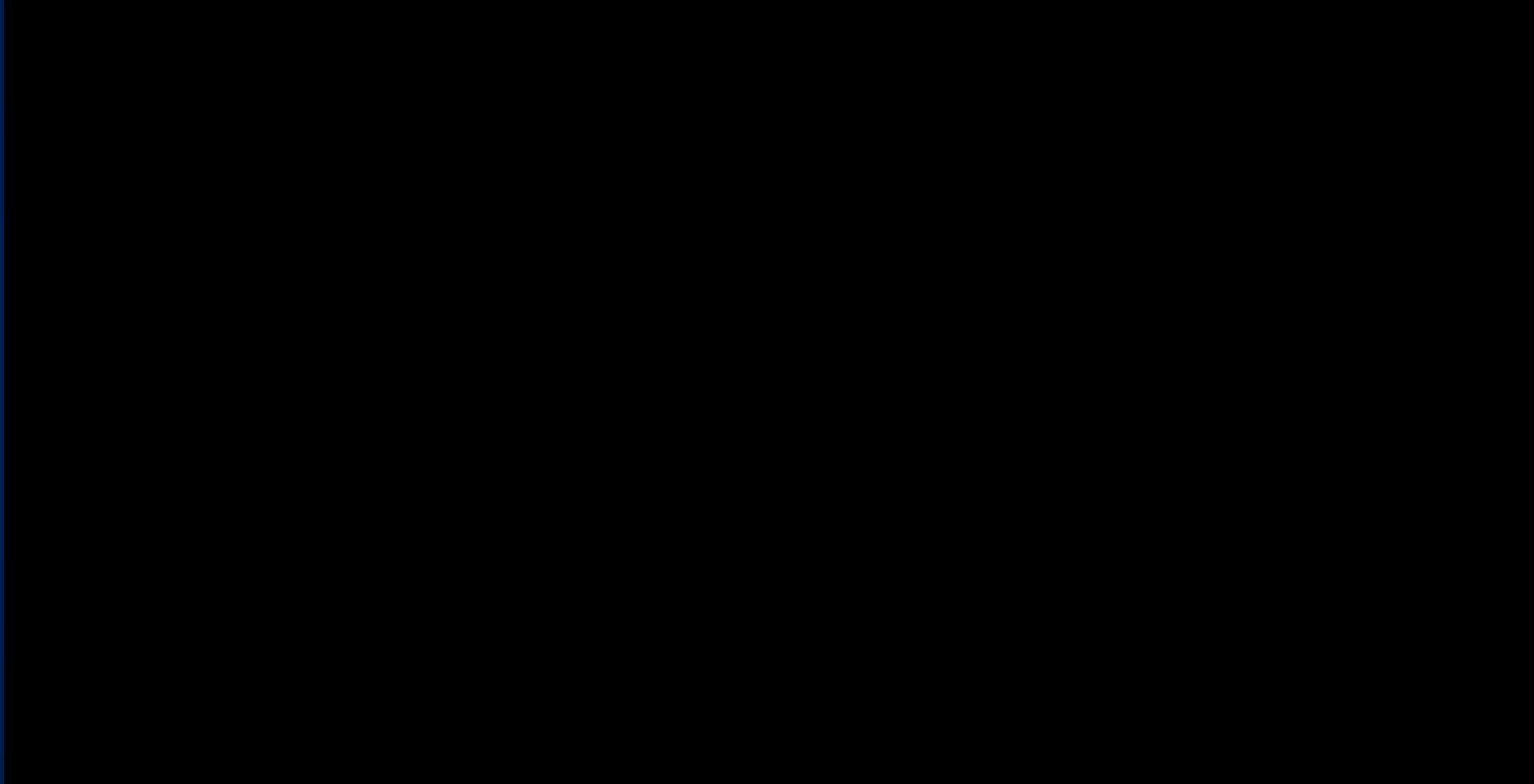
# Move Over Law

- Michigan Law:
  - Move Over a Lane AND Slow 10 mph below the speed limit
  - Applies to emergency vehicles, tow trucks, construction vehicles, and Safety Service Patrols that have a visual signal by means of flashing, rotating, or oscillating red, blue, white, or amber lights.

To improve traffic safety for motorists and workers alike, troopers will collaborate with the Michigan Department of Transportation to conduct speed enforcement in work zones throughout the state.

- In 2023, there were:

- 8,017 work zone crashes

- 24 work zone deaths

- 1,896 work zone injuries
