
Our Mission

Professional Driver Coaching/Driver Performance Measurement

- Drivers receive one-on-one attention on the road with a professional driving coach to enhance their driving skill.
- The program is designed to evaluate driver behaviors or responses compared to standardized observable behaviors specific to locations and traffic.



National Safety Council Defensive Driving Course for Professional Truck Drivers

 This course developed and certified by the National Safety Council to teach and encourage defensive driving strategies to professional truck drivers.




Mobile Truck Simulator

Fatigue Management

 MCTS offers an online interactive fatigue program that lays out the complexities of driver fatigue and provides skills to use to combat fatigue.


New Motor Carrier Compliance Assistance

 The center provides training to fleet managers, personnel managers, etc. on required vehicle and driver files and retention.




Size Weight and Load

 8:30am 5:00pm




Public Information and Education
